



*****IMPORTANT MESSAGE ABOUT THE COST OF INSULIN*****

As of January 1, 2023, Clear Spring Health can't charge more than \$35 for a one-month supply of each Part-D covered insulin product, and you don't have to pay a deductible for your insulin. You'll pay \$35 (\$30 at a Clear Spring Health preferred pharmacy) for a one-month supply of each Part-D covered insulin product, even if you get Extra Help to lower your prescription drug costs.

If you purchased a Part D-covered insulin drug and paid more than \$35 for any month's supply between January 1, 2023 and March 31, 2023, Clear Spring Health will reimburse you within 30 calendar days for the amount you paid that's over the \$35 per month's supply. If you believe you are owed a reimbursement, please call our Member Services department at the telephone number below.

Beginning April 1, 2023, your cost-sharing for certain Medicare Part B drugs will not exceed 20% coinsurance. There is no deductible for Medicare Part B Insulin Drugs, Chemotherapy and Other Medicare Part B drugs.

If you use a traditional insulin pump furnished through one of Clear Spring Health's durable medical equipment partners, you will have a copayment cap of \$35 for a one-month supply for your Part B covered insulin. Beginning July 1, 2023, your cost for a month's supply of Part B-covered insulin for your pump can't be more than \$35, and the Part B deductible won't apply.
